**PALM BEACH, FLA.** - Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary (PBM+C), presented by Art Miami, returns for its seventh edition Thursday, March 21 through Sunday, March 24, 2024 at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. PBM+C brings world-class, investment-quality works from the 20th and 21st centuries with a roster of internationally respected galleries from Austria, United Kingdom, France, Germany, Canada, Columbia, Venezuela and the United States, to one of the most culturally savvy and discerning collecting audiences in the world.

The fair will open with an exclusive, invitation-only VIP Preview benefiting the **Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens** on Thursday, March 21, 2024 and will kick-off with the presentation of the **Lifetime Achievement Award** to American art collector, film producer, actress, model, and Warhol superstar (Baby) Jane Holzer in the VIP Lounge (by invitation only). Previous PBM+C Lifetime Achievement Award recipients include philanthropist Frances Fisher, American art patron and philanthropist Beth Rudin De Woody, South Florida arts and culture advocate Rena Blades, and artist Bruce Helander.

Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens will once again serve as a satellite venue for the fair and will showcase an exciting exhibition by **2024 Artist in Residence Jordi Mollà**, *Savage Garden (Jardín Salvaje)*, in partnership with Paul Fisher Gallery. Born in 1968 in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain, Mollà has earned international acclaim as an accredited actor, painter, writer, and director. A renowned visual artist, Mollà has been on a remarkable roll, his more than 30 year painting career has exploded in the last several years with multiple international exhibitions that push the edge of the avant garde. *Savage Garden* is a tour de force of new work rooted in nature and flowing with surrealist energy, ambition and imagination.

**Holden Luntz Gallery, Palm Beach** will showcase a special exhibition at the entry to the Fair entitled **Bernie Taupin – Two Sides of the Sixties** featuring 15 mixed-media paintings by Taupin, each a re-imagining of the iconic photographs by his dear friend, Terry O'Neill.

Born Bernard John Taupin, Bernie Taupin is a life-long artist. Over the years, Taupin's artwork has evolved from abstract expressionist to text-based content and minimalist pop-art concepts. His multi-layered creations include manipulated flags, scorched canvas, wax, wire, wood, cardboard, fabric, resin.

"My dimensional work is simply the visual extension of what I have spent my life creating through words," says Taupin.

"This is a fantastic highlight this year!" said Nick Korniloff, Director of Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary. "Fresh after receiving the 2024 Gershwin Prize for Popular Song with lifetime musical partner, Sir Elton John, Bernie Taupin will be on-site and join the global art community of collectors, celebrities, and esteemed figures in the art world."

Beginning Friday, March 22, the Fair will open to the public allowing attendees to discover and view an array of world-class, investment-quality works from leading international galleries. The weekend provides an opportunity for seasoned and budding collectors alike to acquire curated works from blue-chip contemporary, post-war and modern masters, emerging talent and mid-career artists such as Banksy, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Fernando Botero, Alexander Calder, Dale Chihuly, Christo, Chuck Close, George Condo, Keith Haring, Damien Hirst, David Hockney, Alex Katz, KAWS, Ellsworth Kelly, Yayoi Kusama, Roy Lichtenstein, Joan Miró, Pablo Picasso, Man Ray, Ugo Rondinone, Kenny Scharf, Andy Warhol.

Throughout the weekend, guests will enjoy onsite amenities including a café, VIP Lounge, convenient parking and more. A complimentary shuttle between the fair and Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens will be available to guests during limited fair hours.

PBM+C 2024 will coincide with the world-renowned Palm Beach International Boat Show, located along the waterfront and Flagler Drive in downtown West Palm Beach. PBM+C VIP cardholders receive complimentary one-day admission to the boat show.
