

# PALM BEACH MODERN + CONTEMPORARY KICKS OFF 2019 WITH WORLD-CLASS INTERNATIONAL ART FAIR FOR THIRD EDITION

The **Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary Art Fair (PBM+C)**, presented by Art Miami and hosted by the **City of West Palm Beach**, will return for its third edition in West Palm Beach City's Tent Site (825 S Dixie Hwy at Okeechobee Blvd) on Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019. PBM+C is the most important fair to take place in Palm Beach during the winter season as it brings a world-class, internationally respected group of art dealers and their artists to one of the most culturally savvy and discerning collecting audiences in the world.

The fair will open on Thursday evening at 5:00pm, with an exclusive VIP Preview benefiting the **Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens** and **Joe Namath Foundation**. Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary, an integral part of the prestigious Art Miami Group, which just celebrated its 29<sup>th</sup> edition of Art Miami, presents a world-class art fair in Palm Beach, which curates and offers the best investment quality works from the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries. The Fair will take place in the intimate and modern setting of a temperature controlled clear span pavilion, conveniently located behind Restoration Hardware, between CityPlace and the luxurious Hilton West Palm Beach.

Collectors, art connoisseurs and art world luminaries alike will have the opportunity to acquire investment quality blue chip, modern and contemporary, and post-war works from nearly 70 top international galleries over the four days of the fair. These premier galleries come from as far as Austria, United Kingdom, France, Germany, Canada, Columbia, Venezuela and throughout the United States. ## **Gallery Highlights**

- Waterhouse & Dodd will present *Food Bowls*, 2005, by Wayne Thiebaud valued at approximately \$3-million, *Forest Scene (Study)*, 1980, by Roy Lichtenstein valued at \$1,475,000, *Untitled*, 1969, by Joan Mitchell, valued at \$1.1-million, and *Bouquet d'oeillets aux amoureux en vert*, 1950, by Marc Chagall, valued at \$900,000.
- Schacky Art will showcase two paintings by Josef Albers, Study to Homage to the Square: Yellow Affirmation, 1954, priced at \$950,000, and Contented Green, 1948-1955, priced at \$700,000, that celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the Bauhaus in 1919. They will also bring a Pablo Picasso drawing from his 1961 Les Déjeuners series. The drawing had been tucked away in a private collection for decades and only recently became public. The drawing is priced at \$275,000.
- Kovacek Contemporary Vienna will highlight various work by German and Austrian Modern artists including *Architecture with stars II*, 1945, by Lyonel Feininger, priced at \$850,000 as well as *Carletto Ponti*, 1970, by Oskar Kokoschka, priced at \$400,000. They will also present work from two contemporary artists Sabine J. Wiedenhofer and Doug Argue, who will join the gallery at their booth.
- **ARCHEUS / POST-MODERN** will present *Untitled (Black and Gray)*, 2009, by **Jonas Wood**, valued at \$485,000.
- Eckert Fine Art, Ct will feature *The Gates (Project for Central Park, NYC)*, 2000, by Christo. The collage comes directly from the artist's collection and is priced at \$450,000.
- Gilden's Art Gallery will present *Untitled*, 1963, by Alexander Calder, valued at \$110,000.
- David Benrimon Fine Art will showcase Nude Reading (C. 288), 1994, and Reflections on Crash (from Reflections series), 1990, both by Roy Lichtenstein, Bliss Bucket, 2010, by Ed Ruscha, and Andy Warhol's Grace Kelly, 1984, and Superman (F. & S. II. 260), 1981.
- JF Gallery will exhibit *George Michael* by Christina Major that has never been seen before.
- Nikola Rukaj Gallery will build on their success at Art Miami and present a series of eight pieces from Alex Katz's *Coca-Cola Girls* series.
- **Trident Gallery** will feature two paintings by **Peter Lyons** including *Mondo Exotica*, and four smaller paintings as well as work by **Susan Erony**.
- **BOGENA GALERIE** will present four paintings by **Monique Frydman** that have never been seen before as well as work from **Antoni Tapies** and **Christian Lapie**.



• Heather Gaudio Fine Art will showcase work from artists including Ellen Carey, who was included as one of the Top 100 Women in Photography by the Royal Photographic Society, Martin Kline, who has work at the Metropolitan Museum of Art and The Whitney Museum of American Art, and Melissa Meyer, whose work is at the Museum of Modern Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum, and the Brooklyn Museum.
