PALM BEACH, FL. - Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary (PBM+C), presented by Art Miami, returns for its eighth edition Thursday, March 20 through Sunday, March 23, 2025 at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. PBM+C brings world-class, investment-quality works from the 20th and 21st centuries with a roster of internationally respected galleries from 18 countries including Spain, the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Canada, The Netherlands, Colombia, Switzerland and the United States, to one of the most culturally savvy and discerning collecting audiences in the world.

The fair will open with an exclusive, invitation-only VIP Preview benefiting the **Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens** on Thursday, March 20, 2025. Beginning Friday, March 21, the Fair will open to the public allowing attendees to discover and view an array of world-class, investment-quality works from leading international galleries. The weekend provides an opportunity for seasoned and budding collectors alike to acquire curated works from blue-chip contemporary, post-war and modern masters, emerging talent and mid-career artists such as **Alex Katz, Julian Opie, David Hockney, Yayoi Kusama, Andy Warhol, Keith Haring, Alexander Calder, Salustiano, Henry Moore, Yigal Ozeri, Russell Young, Swoon, Nemo Jantzen, Robert Strati, Helen Frankenthaler, Mel Bochner, David Yarrow, Ross Bleckner, Elise Ansel, David Dessens, Boris van Berkum, Madeleine Gross, Hwang Seontae, Mary Abbott and more.**

Holden Luntz Gallery, Palm Beach will showcase a special exhibition at the entry to the Fair by **David Yarrow** featuring a series of photographs by Yarrow, each capturing the raw beauty of wildlife, landscapes, and human storytelling. With a cinematic approach and unparalleled attention to detail, his work transcends traditional wildlife photography, offering a unique perspective that merges art, storytelling, and conservation. The exhibition **will benefit Tusk, a leading conservation organization** with over 30 years of experience, drives innovative and impactful initiatives to protect Africa's wildlife and support sustainable community development.

Highlights from the Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary Fair this year include:

- **Blond Contemporary** (London) is presenting a compelling dialogue between contemporary greats and young artists such as David Hockney, Bridget Riley, Henry Blond and Sophia Bounou
- **Raphael** (Frankfurt) highlights include a canvas work by Andy Warhol, a watercolor piece by Alexander Calder and an Alex Katz latest edition screen print
- **Ascaso Gallery** (Miami) is emphasizing the exhibition of works by Venezuelan artists, consecrated maestros and new talents including Fernando Botero, Jesus Rafael Soto and Reynier Ferrer
- **Contessa Gallery** (Palm Beach) is presenting works by American post-conceptual artist Rob Pruitt, exploring the topic of climate change
- **Cynthia Corbett Gallery** (London) is showcasing a group show with pieces ranging across painting, photography and contemporary craft featuring 14 international artists including Miles Regis, Elaine Woo MacGregor and Freya Bramble-Carter

- **Liquid art system** (Miami) is highlighting works by Tiffany Trendera exploring the interaction between artificial intelligence and the human body
- **Tagliatella Galleries** (New York City) is reintroducing *JETER*, an exclusive collaboration with Major League Baseball and renowned pop artist Russell Young which debuted at Art Miami 2024
- **Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary Talks** - Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary Talks offers engaging conversations with artists and curators, exploring the intersection of art, technology, and creative innovation. All talks will be hosted at the VIP Lounge.

 - Art critic and artist Bruce Helander will moderate a talk with artist and Cultural Partner Tyler K. Smith on his selected works on view at the fair as well as those from his recent exhibition at the Lighthouse ArtCenter in Tequesta. The discussion will focus on the process and dramatic presentation of Smith's imaginative science fiction imagery.

"I am thrilled to once again welcome the global art community to Palm Beach," said Nick Korniloff, Director of Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary. "Each year, this fair continues to be a dynamic cultural moment where art, innovation, and influence converge, and 2025 will be no exception."

Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens will once again serve as a satellite venue for the fair and will showcase an exciting exhibition by **2025 Artist in Residence Jane Manus**, *Old Friends*. Renowned for her bold geometric forms and industrial materials, sculptor Jane Manus creates dynamic, large-scale abstract works that embody a sense of movement and modernist precision. Her striking aluminum sculptures that explore the interplay of line, space, and structure have been exhibited internationally and are featured in numerous public and private collections.

Pioneering American artist **Alex Katz** will debut a special exhibition, *Portraits and Landscapes Through The Season*, presented by Sponder Gallery. The show will open on the night of the **Evening of Music & Art in the Gardens at Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens**, showcasing works that highlight his enduring exploration of beauty, nature, and the human figure.

Additionally, **Lighthouse ArtCenter** will debut works by **Tyler K. Smith**, a New York-based multidisciplinary artist, set designer, exhibit designer, and educator. In the VIP Lounge of Palm Beach Modern + Contemporary, Lighthouse ArtCenter will present a corresponding Talk between Smith and local artist Bruce Helander on Saturday, March 22.

Throughout the weekend, guests will enjoy onsite amenities including a café, VIP Lounge, convenient parking and more. A complimentary shuttle between the fair and Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens will be available to guests during limited fair hours.

PBM+C 2025 will coincide with the world-renowned Palm Beach International Boat Show, located along the waterfront and Flagler Drive in downtown West Palm Beach. PBM+C VIP cardholders receive complimentary one-day admission to the boat show.
